## KANGAROO PELLETS







Nutritional supplement for Australian herbivores including kangaroos, wallabies & wombats.

Australian herbivores eat a range of native grass & plants providing a high fibre diet, rich in anti-oxidants. However, in captivity they are often fed pellets or grain mixes made from high-starch cereals. This can lead to dental problems (eg Lumpy Jaw) and poor digestive health.

## **Benefits of Wombaroo Kangaroo Pellets**

High in Fibre: Abrasive fibre promotes chewing action and maintains good digestive condition.

Low Starch: reduces dental and gut problems associated with cereal grain diets.

**High in Anti-oxidants:** Vitamin E, Selenium and carotenoids reduce oxidative stress and support immune system.

Low in Oxalates: oxalates present in plants such as lucerne can bind dietary minerals and form urinary tract stones. A low oxalate diet may assist mineral absorption and urinary tract health.

**Directions:** Feed **Wombaroo Pellets** as up to 15% of the diet. The majority of the diet should be pasture, hay & browse, depending on the individual species' requirements. Avoid feeding large amounts of high-sugar fruit, starch (grains, bread, root vegetables) or high-oxalate fodder (eg lucerne).
